- 9 部 門 (1) 暗唱部門(暗唱例文①か②、または自分で選んだ英文 3分以内)  
(2) スピーチ部門(3分以内のスピーチ 演題は自由)
- 10 審査基準 内容・発音・話し方などの基準で、部門別に評価する。
- 11 審 査 員 中部大学教授、ネイティブスピーカー
- 12 表 彰 暗唱部門は「発音」・「発表の仕方」、スピーチ部門は「発音」・「発表の仕方」・「発表内容」の各部門において、最も優れた分野について発表者全員を表彰する。  
なお、その中から各部門で特に優れた上位5名を特別に表彰する。(賞状・副賞)また、特別に表彰された各部門上位5名は、本校の入学試験において優遇する。
